On Tuesday, June 15, 2021, D.E.P.AN. - City Network successfully conducted an online public debate to discuss "The joint strategy on the Biodiversity Preservation" with stakeholders from Greece in the framework of the project "MOBILE BIODIVERSITY" of the Cooperation Program "Interreg V - A Greece Bulgaria".

The project "MOBILE BIODIVERSITY" is implemented within the Cooperation Program "Interreg V - A Greece - Bulgaria" of the Programming Period 2014-2020 which is co-funded by 85% from the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) and by 15% from national resources of the participating countries.
